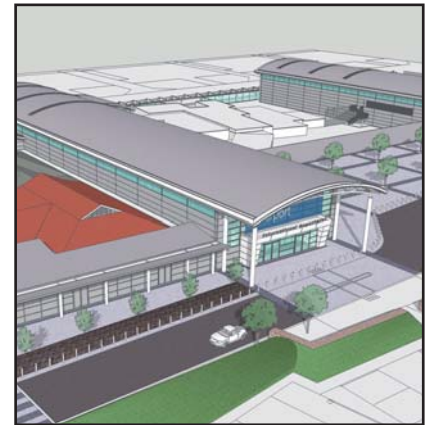

Scheme:

The £45 million scheme centres on expanding and updating the existing terminal building, providing a new arrivals building and energy centre, landscaping and works to upgrade the airport infrastructure along with an additional c.3,000 car park spaces.

It has been proposed to effectively double the size of the terminal to improve conditions for the current usage of almost one million passengers a year and to cater for a predicted three-fold increase over the next decade.
